

## 2022 Pre-Register Workshops

### KIDS

**Tie-Dye for Kids** with *Brenda Bonter*. This workshop is limited to 10 participants, ages 5-15, for each session: Saturday 9:00-9:30 am and 9:30-10:00am. **Pre-registration is recommended**

**Beginning Acrylic Painting for Families** with *Rebecca Start*. This workshop will include an intro to basic supplies, types of paint strokes, transferring a drawing to canvas and a step-by-step guided painting. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult. This workshop is Sunday 10:00am -12:00pm. Limited to 10 participants. **Pre-registration is recommended.**

**Jig Doll Making** with *Rachel & Wally Ewing*. The Jig Doll workshop provides a chance for 'parent & child' to assemble and create a unique looking wooden Jig-Doll. And thereafter, learn how to make them dance as Wally and Rachel Ewing provide some ole time music. Come make a memory as you re-live a tradition from long ago. This workshop will be Saturday 1:00-2:00 pm and repeated Sunday 2:00-3:00 pm. Each workshop is limited to 12 participants, ages 5 – 17. **Pre-registration is recommended.**

**Ice Cream Making** with *Carol Foerch*. Making ice cream in a Ziploc bag is easy and fun! Use cream, ice cubes and a couple ingredients to work up a tasty treat! This workshop is Saturday 2:30-3:30 pm and 3:30-4:30 pm. Each session is limited to 25 participants ages 9 & up. **Pre-registration recommended.** Note: hands will get very cold so you might want to bring mittens or a small towel.

### ADULT

**Intermediate Acrylic Painting** with *Rebecca Start*. This workshop is for those who have experience with acrylic painting. The workshop will review supplies, discuss choosing reference photo, importance of value & color in a painting, transferring a drawing to canvas and a step-by-step guided painting. The workshop is Saturday 9:30-11:00 am and is limited to 10 participants ages 16 & up. **Pre-registration is recommended.**

**Advanced Tie Dye** with *Janet McFarland*. Participants will make an eight point bottle dyed mandala, 42"x48". This workshop is limited to 12 participants, adult only. Workshop is Saturday 9:00-11:00 am and finish on Sunday 1:30-2:30 pm to untie and rinse. **Pre-registration is recommended.**

**Soapmaking** with *Joy Castonguay* Lye soap? Yup! But not all lye soap is created equal. Times have changed, and we'll take advantage of techniques and readily-available ingredients that our great-grandmothers didn't have access to. Learn to make mild, beautifully-scented soaps

without spending hours stirring a kettle of boiling goo. Leave with a pound of your own customized soap AND the confidence to make it again! This class limited to 20 participants, ages 16 and up. This workshop will be offered twice; Saturday 9:30-11:30 am and 1:00-3:00 pm.

**Pre-registration is recommended.**

**Carving a Walking Stick** *with Paul Marsh.* This workshop will focus on how to select materials, shame size and finish handmade walking sticks from locally provided material. Participants will walk the Wheatland grounds looking for “blanks” – branches that have fallen – and through personalized instruction will make their own project. This class is limited to 12 teens (12 & up) and adults. This workshop is offered twice; Saturday 9:00-11:00 am 11:00 am–1:00 pm. **Pre-registration is recommended.**

**Wool Dyeing Demonstration** *with Sue Ann Carpenter.* Sue Ann will demonstrate dyeing wool (protein based animal fiber) using a natural dye material, specifically marigolds. There will be discussion during the demonstration of natural and commercial dyes for animal fibers. This workshop is Saturday 1:00-3:00 pm and is limited to 25 participants age 15 & up. **Pre-registration is recommended.**

**Stoneware Face Jug Pottery** *with Erica Shirey and Rita Shields.* Learn about the fascinating history of ceramic face jugs in America and hand-build your own functional, stoneware jug. This workshop is Saturday 1:00-4:00 pm and is limited to 15 participants, ages 17 & up. If you took this workshop previously, you are not eligible to take it again. **Pre-registration is recommended.**

**Polish Star Ornaments** *with Diane Scheuermann.* Participants will make a traditional Polish Christmas ornament using paper, glue small beads or sequins, string or thin ribbon and a pencil. The workshop- is Saturday 1:00-3:30 pm and is limited to 20 participants, ages 12 & up. **Pre-registration is recommended.**

**Zipper Bracelet** *with Kathy Hillman.* Participants will make a unique bracelet using a zipper and buttons. If you have any buttons, beads, earring (perhaps you lost 1 of the pair), bring them in a Ziploc bag to the workshop. Knowledge of basic sewing is helpful but not necessary. This workshop is Saturday 12:00-4:00 pm; limited to 30 participants 14 & up.. **Pre-registration is recommended.**

**Macrame Mohair Guitar Strap** *with Pop Wagner* – The process for making these mohair guitar straps was adapted from traditional mohair saddle cinch weaving techniques. Metal buckles on the saddle cinches have been replaced with leather ends for the guitar straps. Learn to make one of these for yourself in this three hour workshop. Looms and hand tools provided for use during the class. This workshop is limited to 8 adults but will be offered twice, Saturday 1:30 – 4:30 pm and Sunday 9:30 am -12:30 pm. **Pre-registration is recommended.**

**Painting a Pre-Printed Drawing with Acrylic Paints** *with Carole Howard.* Participants will paint a pre-drawn picture of birch trees and the moon using acrylic paints. This workshop is offered Sunday, 9:30 – 11:00 AM. Limited to 15 participants; Adults only. **Pre-registration is recommended.**

**Yarn 101** *with Sue Ann Carpenter.* A discussion of yarns available to crafters. Types of material used in the yarns and properties of the yarns. This workshop is Sunday 10:00-11:00 am for 25 participants, ages 15 & up. **Pre-registration is recommended.**

**Stoneware Face Jug Pottery for Teens** *with Erica Shirey and Rita Shields.* Learn about the fascinating history of ceramic face jugs in America and hand-build your own functional, stoneware jug. This workshop is Sunday 1:00-4:00 pm and is limited to 15 participants, ages 12-16. **Pre-registration is recommended.**
