Member ticket sales will be June 6-17, 2022, for those with a paid membership purchased by May 31, 2022. Orders are limited to the number of adult and/or senior tickets per membership level. Member tickets are available by calling the office at 989-967-8879 or 989-967-8561, between 8:30 am & 3:30 pm.

Sales to the general public will begin the morning of June 20, 2022, until they are sold out. Tickets may be purchased online, by calling the office, or with a mail-in form. All ticket orders place June 20 and after are limited to a maximum of 8 adult and/or senior tickets.

Tickets will be VERY limited this year as many tickets purchased in 2021 were rolled over to 2022. If you rolled your tickets over, please contact the office if you have moved. 2022 wristbands will be mailed during June & July.
