EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS REPORT

- 1. Festival attendance was approximately 12,700. The roll-over wristbands were problematic.
- 2. Mail delivery was a problem again. We are considering adding a \$5 fee per package for priority mailing status.
- 3. An operational grant of \$19,500 was received from Michigan Arts & Culture Council.
- 4. The November newsletter will focus on volunteer recruitment. December will begin the annual membership campaign.

- 1. Comments were made re: differing levels of volunteering and incentives. A committee is being formed to address these and other volunteering issues.
- 2. Melissa Zemer, currently working with Land Management, will be assuming Supply duties.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Donor reception: 200+ invitations were sent out. The proposed sculpture project was reviewed, with \$2000 in donations already received toward the estimated cost of \$35,000.
